

# swingo 250µmicro B

## Preparation

- 

**1** Remove orange cover tank from machine.
- 

**2** Remove battery from machine.
- 

**3** Fit clean brushes or pad holders with clean pads.
- 

**4** Fit squeegee.
- 

**5** Remove white solution tank from orange cover tank.
- 

**6** Fill white solution tank with clean water. Dose cleaning product into solution tank.
- 

**7** Replace battery into machine.
- 

**8** Refit white solution tank into orange cover tank and refit into machine.

## Operation

- 

**9** Prime both water flow levers.
- 

**10** Set both water flow levers for application. 5 settings from low to high (-) or (+).
- 

**11** Disengage parking/ storage mode using foot pedal.
- 

**12** Engage squeegee using foot pedal.
- 

**13** Release orange height lever for operating position.
- 

**14** Squeeze orange control lever whilst pressing yellow button to start.
- 

**15** Press vacuum button on/off.
- 

**16** Press water button on/off

- 

**17** Press orange button and move into upright position to lock handle for parking/storage.
- 

**18** Disengage squeegee by lifting up squeegee with foot.
- 

**19** Lower machine with locked handle to 45% to engage transport/storage wheels.

## Maintenance

- 

**20** Remove orange tank cover to empty both tanks.
- 

**21** Open and remove clear recovery tank cover. Empty and rinse.
- 

**22** Clean and replace ball float before next use.
- 

**23** Empty and rinse white solution tank. Refit into orange cover tank.
- 

**24** Remove battery and place on charge. Charger indicators: Green = charging, Green flashing = no battery, Red = charging, Red flashing = error
- 

**25** Replace orange tank cover on to machine.
- 

**26** Clean and rinse and replace brushes/pad drives/pads. Replace pads as needed.
- 

**27** Remove, check and clean squeegee.
- 

**28** Clean machine with damp cloth. Store with tank open to dry.
